**Week 1 -- Player Highlights**

**Offense - #28 RB - Brandon Schell**

The sophomore rushed for a team-best 81 yards in the opening game and ranks in a tie for eighth in the NSIC in that category. Schell had a long run of 21 yards in the game.

**Defense #20 SS - Shea DeJong**

The true freshman shined in his collegiate debut, recording a game-high 12 tackles in the Dragons' opening game against Wayne State. DeJong had four unassisted tackles and eight assists, along with a tackle for a loss. He is tied for sixth in the NSIC in that category.

**Special Teams #2 WR/KR - Barik Williams**

The senior had a solid game as a kick returner for the Dragons, recording an average of 26.8 yards on four returns. Williams had a long return of 36 yards. His average of 26.8 yards ranks him ninth in the NSIC.

**Game Preview**

The Minnesota State University Moorhead football team takes to the road for the first time in 2012 when it plays at NSIC newcomer Sioux Falls on Saturday at Bob Young Field in Sioux Falls, S.D. Game time is 1 p.m.

**MSU Moorhead Dragons**

MSUM and second-year head coach Steve Laqua will look to break in the win column this week against a solid USF squad. The Dragons will look to build on the positives from their opening game against Wayne State.

Sophomore Brandon Schell's 81-yard game on the ground led the rushing attack. Redshirt freshman quarterback Myles Montplaisir, after going 5-of-15 in the first half in his first collegiate start, was 5-of-10 in the second half. Freshman Adam Jiskra's four catches led the receiving corp.

Another bright spot in the opener for MSUM was its kick return game, as senior Barik Williams had four returns for 107 yards, including a long return of 36 yards.

On defense, DeJong's 12 tackles led the way. Sophomore linebacker Nick Seedorff had nine tackles.

**Sioux Falls Cougars**

The Cougars and third-year head coach Jed Stugart are off to a 1-0 start after the 32-19 win over St. Cloud State in the opening week. USF outgained the Huskies 418-320, including 164-97 on the ground.

Quarterback Taylor Perkins threw for 254 yards and three scores, with Carrington Hanna catching eight passes for 113 yards and two scores. On defense, the Cougars recorded four sacks and also had an interception. Linebacker Matt White had nine tackles, including two sacks. final minute to cut the gap to 32-19.

Stugart has a record of 19-5 at USF.

**Week 1 Dragon Notes**

The Dragons' youth movement officially began Saturday in the season-opening 49-6 loss to Wayne State. MSUM started six true freshmen on offense and four on defense. And while there were some growing pains, several young players shined. That included freshman safety Shea DeJong, who had a game-high 12 tackles, including one for loss. That ranks him in a tie for sixth in the NSIC after one game. That also includes freshman receiver Adam Jiskra, who had four catches for 76 yards, with a long catch of 27 yards. Freshman receiver Tyler Rivard had two catches, while freshman tight end Wade Youngblom had a catch as well. Freshman running back Zayne Medhaug scored the Dragons' touchdown. Three freshmen linemen -- Bennen Bierman, Troy Peterson and Jake Antolak -- also started in their collegiate debuts for MSUM.

# MINNESOTA STATE UNIVERSITY MOORHEAD DRAGONS

## A WORD FROM COACH

The Dragons' young lineup got tested for the first time in the loss to Wayne State on Sept. 1. With a redshirt freshman starting at quarterback and six true freshmen starting on the offense, along with four freshmen on the defense, to say that the lineup was "young" was an understatement.

While it was a tough opening loss -- there were also signs of promise from the team's young players.

"Our speed and athleticism is much improved from a year ago," MSUM head coach Steve Laqua said following the game. "There were some bigger hits and high-speed collisions. There are tangible signs of progress. The downside of that youth is the inconsistency."

It was a true freshman -- safety Shea DeJong -- that led the Dragons with 12 tackles. It was another true freshman, receiver Adam Jiskra, who led the team with four catches for 76 yards.

In addition, redshirt freshman Myles Montplaisir, making his first collegiate start at quarterback, was 10-of-25 passing for 146 yards. In the second half, he was 5-of-10 passing.

Sophomore linebacker Nick Seedorf had nine tackles while true freshman cornerback Sheldon Jones had seven. Junior linebacker Brad Hauer had a sack, while sophomore Andrew Pittman had an interception. Senior Barik Williams averaged 26.9 yards per kick return.

The task for the Dragons is to continue to progress each week. "Those young guys continued to get better throughout the game," Laqua said. "We have the building blocks in place. It's up to us as a coaching staff to continue to develop those guys."

## COACHING RESUME

- Steve Laqua was named Head Coach in the spring of 2011, becoming the 17th Football Coach in the 93-year history of the program. 2012 is his 6th year as a head coach and the 2nd at the collegiate level.
- In his first season, Laqua led the Dragons to a 2-9 record including his first game as a collegiate head coach and an overtime win on homecoming.
- Laqua coached four players to the All-NSIC team, one to the first team, one to the second, and two to honorable mention.
- Laqua spent four season as the Shanley Deacons head coach prior to joining MSUM.

## COACHING BIO

Steve Laqua joined the Dragon coaching ranks as the 17th Head Coach in school history in the spring of 2011, taking the helm of the football program in its 92nd year in existence. He came to the Dragons after a turning around the Fargo Shanley High School program, as it's head coach for four seasons.

In his first season, Laqua led the Dragons to a 2-9 record including an opening-day victory and a thrilling overtime win on homecoming. Four players were named to the All-Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference team while making a national impact. Jeff Schuette, named to the All-NSIC Second Team, was eighth in the country in tackles followed closely by Tyler Brody, named to the All-NSIC Honorable Mention Team, who was 18th. Laqua signed 23 recruits during his first full offseason to prepare his team for the 2012 season.

Prior to his reign at Shanley, the Deacons had two winless seasons, and under Laqua's guidance became North Dakota State Football Champions during his third year (2009). The team won a tight battle over Devils Lake, 31-30. In 2010, he coached the Deacons to their second state title, as the team topped Devils Lake on a field goal as time expired, 24-21.

Laqua was honored as the the 2009 and 2010 North Dakota High School AA Coach of the Year. During the 2009 season, the Deacon's began their 20-game winning streak, a streak that was active when Laqua resigned his position.

Prior to joining the prep-ranks, Laqua served as the Running Backs, Tight Ends and Punt Team Coach at North Dakota State from January 2005-March 2007, where he coached five All-Americans including Tyler Roehl and Mike Dragosavich.

While at NDSU, Laqua was one of the team's top recruiters, as he was heavily involved in recruiting players from North Dakota, South Dakota and western Minnesota.

He also served as the Bison's academic coordinator where he implemented a program that put an emphasis on study skills and a college degree. As a result, the team had 21-Academic All-Conference players during his two-year stint at NDSU.

For the 2004 season, Laqua was the Minnesota Crookston Golden Eagles' Offensive Coordinator, where he led an offense that led the NSIC in rushing yards, yards per attempt and least turnovers. During that season, he directly coached an NCAA DII All-American Freder Rollins, who was also named a National Player of the Week during the season.

The Golden Eagle offense set records for rushing yards in a season, as well as single game marks. He directed the Golden Eagle offense that led the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in rushing yards, yards per attempt and least turnovers per game.

His coaching experience also extends to one season at St. Olaf College, in Northfield, Minn., where he was the Outside Linebackers Coach. He also served his first stint at NDSU as a Graduate Assistant Coach for tight ends in 2002-03.

Laqua had a decorated career at North Dakota State as a Division II student-athlete, playing quarterback for the Bison. He was an Academic All-Conference member for three years as well as graduated with honors. He earned his Masters of Education from NDSU in 2007.
