THE GAME

The Bemidji State University football team (1-2; 1-2 NSIC, 0-0 NSIC North) faces its third consecutive undefeated team Sept. 22 at 12 p.m. when it travels to University of Sioux Falls (3-0; 3-0 NSIC, 0-0 NSIC South) in a Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference contest at Bob Young Field. The Beavers are also battling their third straight team receiving votes in the AFCA national poll after falling to Wayne State College Sept. 15 20-17 in Bemidji, Minn. New league member Sioux Falls has a 3-0 record after defeating fellow newcomers Minot State University 42-20 in Minot, N.D. last week.

THE SERIES

Saturday's game will mark just the third all-time meeting between Bemidji State and Sioux Falls. BSU and USF met in Sioux Falls, S.D. in 1982 with the Cougars winning 14-12. The next season USF traveled to Bemidji and the Beavers took that game 31-0. More series information on page 7.

THE COACHES

Bemidji State: Jeff Tesch is in his 17th season roaming the sidelines at Bemidji State. He has posted an overall record of 107-69 (.608), which includes a 82-52 (.612) mark in NSIC tilts. In 17 seasons, Tesch has established BSU standards for games coached (176), victories (107), career winning percentage (.608) and conference wins (82). He secured his 100th victory at BSU in grand fashion with a 30-27 overtime upset road victory at then-No. 16 Augustana College Sept. 10, 2011. Prior to his tenure at BSU, Tesch, a two-time NSIC Coach of the Year (1999 and 2006), spent 12 years as an assistant at North Dakota, two on the staff of Central Missouri and one season at Montana State. Sioux Falls: Introduced as USF's 20th head coach February 20, 2010, Jed Stugart is in his third season at the helm with a 21-5 record. In his first season at USF, Stugart led the Cougars to a 13-1 record, fifth straight Great Plains Athletic Conference (GPAC) crown and fifth consecutive appearance in the NIAA National Championship Game. Prior to USF, Stugart served as the linebackers coach at the University of Nevada-Las Vegas (UNLV), compiled a 26-7 record as head coach during three seasons at MidAmerica Nazarene University (MNU) and was on staff at Northern Colorado from 1999-2006.

THE PROGRAM

Bemidji State is in its 87th season of football and owns an all-time record is 324-403-24 (.447) dating back to 1926, which includes a 185-253-9 (.424) mark in NSIC play. The Beavers own five conference titles (1947, 50, 57, 59 and 2006) and count the 2006 Mineral Water Bowl as their first post-season appearance. Under the direction of Tesch, BSU has posted winning records in 13 of the last 14 years and have registered 10 consecutive winning home campaigns.

GAME QUICK SNAP

- Sioux Falls is receiving votes in the AFCA poll.
- BSU was 4-0 against the NSIC South last season and are 5-2 in the last seven meetings with the division.
- The Cougars own the third best scoring offense in the league (28th in the nation), posting 39.7 points per game, while the defense has allowed only 16.3 points per contest to sit fourth in the NSIC and 23rd nationally.
- The Beavers have the second best pass defense in the NSIC, while sitting third in total defense after allowing an average of 295.3 yards in the first three games of the season.
- USF senior defensive back Robert Virgil ranks tied for second nationally with an average of an interception per game.
- Junior punter/place kicker **Zach Pulkinen** is third in the NSIC punting average (41.2 yds/gm), senior quarterback **Lance Rongstad** is tied for fourth in total offense (269.3 yds/gm) and senior linebacker **Cory Crosby** is fifth in the league in tackles with 33 (12 solo).

SEASON LONG COUNT

- BSU has posted a winning record in 12 of the last 13 seasons under head coach **Jeff Tesch**.
- The Beavers also have 10 consecutive winning seasons at home after going 5-1 in 2011 to tie a program record for wins at home (1985 - 5-0 and 2000 - 5-0).
- Tesch signed a new six-year contract extension over the summer.
- BSU was tabbed sixth overall and third in the NSIC North in the Preseason NSIC Coaches' Poll.
- The Beavers returned 16 starters from a 2011 team that ranked in the national poll on three different occasions - including seven all-conference players.
- The Beaver offense finished the 2011 season averaging 26.8 points per game and welcomed eight starters, including 2011 All-American and 2012 preseason All-American tight end **Brian Leonhardt**.
- The 'Gang Green' defense returned seven starters from a year ago. Anchored by pre-season All-American nose guard **Matthew Shaver**, the BSU defense was one of the best in the conference in 2011 allowing just 16.0 points per contest to rank No. 3 in the nation.
- 2012 captains are senior quarterback **Lance Rongstad** and Leonhardt on the offensive side of the ball and the defensive captains are senior linebacker **Cory Crosby** and junior linebacker **Buckley Wright**.
- Leonhardt was named a preseason All-American by four publications. Senior return specialist **Beau Wakefield** and Shaver also earned preseason All-American laurels.
- Leonhardt owns 1,148 career receiving yards, ranking second among Bemidji State tight ends since 1971 (Bruce Ecklund, 1,542 yards, 1980-83).
- The Beavers were 4-1 in 2011 when senior **Dustin Kroeplin** rushed for a touchdown and are 17-2 in his three-year career when he finds the end zone from the backfield. Through the air or on the ground, the Beavers hold a 18-3 record.
- Rongstad was named *NSIC Offensive Player of the Week* Sept. 4 after his performance against Upper Iowa. He totaled 228 passing yards, a career-high four passing touchdowns and led the team in rushing with 58 yards.
- He was the first *NSIC Offensive Player of the Week* from Bemidji State since Anthony Schreiber in 2006.
- Not so good stat of the Week: The Beavers have lost 10 fumbles in 2012, six more than the second most lost in the league, and are last in the NSIC in turnover margin (-3.00).

HOME COOKIN'

At home, the Beavers have a streak of 10 winning seasons, including the 2011 season where they went 5-1 to tie the program record for home victories in a season. Since **Jeff Tesch** took the helm of the BSU football program prior to the 1996 season, the Beavers

have posted a 58-23 overall record with a 47-17 mark in NSIC play at "The Chet." Tesch and the Beavers own undefeated home slates in 1998 (4-0), 2000 (5-0) and 2005 (4-0).

BEAVERS VERSUS RANKED OPPONENTS

In 2009, BSU faced four nationally-ranked opponents marking the first time the Beavers have battled four of the American Football Coaches Association's (AFCA) top 25 teams in the same season.

Bemidji State went 2-2 versus ranked opponents in 2009 dropping Winona State Oct. 12, then-ranked 20th and earning a 21-10 victory versus No. 14 Wayne State (Neb.) Oct. 10. The Beavers missed a 4-0 mark versus nationally-ranked by the narrowest of margins. BSU battled No. 10 Minnesota State to overtime Sept. 5 before falling to the Mavericks 37-34 and dropped a one-point game, 35-34, to No. 7 Minnesota Duluth Oct. 24. In 2010, BSU fell to the Bulldogs, who were ranked No. 2 in the AFCA poll, 44-21. Augustana found its way in the top 25 in the AFCA and DII Football polls after defeating Bemidji State 10-0 Sept. 11. St. Cloud State was ranked 25th in the 35-14 loss to the Huskies Nov. 6.

Augustana College was ranked No. 16 in the nation when it met BSU Sept. 10. The Beavers used overtime to down the Vikings on their home field, winning 30-27. The Beavers defeated Augustana to earn their first win against a ranked opponent since defeating then-No. 14 Wayne State College 21-10 Oct. 10, 2009.

The Beavers fell to then-No. 11 Minnesota Duluth Sept. 24 by the score of 26-23, but defeated then-No. 6 St. Cloud State 19-14 Nov. 5. The win marked the highest ranked team the Beavers have defeated in program history. It also was the second time in three years BSU had defeated two ranked opponents in a season.

BSU is 5-10 under head coach **Jeff Tesch** against ranked opponents in his 17 seasons at BSU. In 2012, BSU is 0-2 in teams receiving votes in the national poll.

It begins in early fall with the turning of the leaves. Students, proud alumni and families from surrounding communities file into a small, picturesque stadium on the shore of Lake Bemidji with fevered expectations for the battles to come. Through the autumn combat, those watchful souls have been blessed to witness an unprecedented era of success. All-America honorees. School records falling by the way-side with an almost dazzling regularity. A stadium where victories occurred with the frequency of a bigfoot sighting just a few short years ago now hosts men with annual dreams of championship and glory.

It's an era of success and excitement that once might have seemed akin to the Christmas fantasies of youth. But under the masterful guidance of 17th-year head coach **Jeff Tesch**, the Bemidji State football program has undergone a remarkable metamorphosis and gone from annual doormat to title contender.

Tesch has posted a 107-69 record at BSU and led the Beavers to a school-record streak of 10 consecutive winning seasons from 1998-2007. During that historic streak he posted four of the eight eight-win seasons for a program now in its 87th season of competition. He is the only coach in Bemidji State history to oversee back-to-back eight-win seasons, and his 2000 and 2006 teams set matching school records of nine wins.

Tesch's success at BSU has been remarkable. Upon being named BSU's 15th field general in May 1996, he inherited a program which had won just 16 games in its previous eight seasons, suffering losing streaks of nine, 11 and 18 games in that time. Today, his 107 wins represent more than 30-percent of the program's all-time victories. He has averaged six wins a season at a program which in 70 years prior to his arrival averaged barely three victories each fall. In fact, Tesch's 107 wins in 17 years surpasses the number of victories garnered by the Bemidji State program in the 34 full seasons prior to his arrival — 105.

Tesch has further cemented his legendary status by becoming Bemidji State's all-time leader in coaching victories. He posted his 53rd win at BSU with a 28-20 victory over Minnesota Crookston on Oct. 16, 2004, moving him past H. "Jolly" Erickson, who won 52 games during a 17-year career at BSU from 1938-54.

Tesch's growing list of achievements at Bemidji State has him amongst the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference's coaching deans as well. A two-time *NSIC Coach of the Year* now in his 17th season at the Bemidji State helm, Tesch and Winona State's Tom Sawyer who enters his 17th year with the Warriors are the longest tenured coaches in the NSIC.

Before taking over at BSU, Tesch spent 11 years as an assistant for annual NCAA Division II playoff contender North Dakota. There, he assumed assistant head coaching duties in 1995. The Fighting Sioux captured at least a share of the North Central Conference championship three consecutive seasons before Tesch's departure in 1996. In addition to coaching duties, Tesch helped the Sioux achieve a 92 percent graduation rate while serving as academic advisor.

Prior to his UND appointment, Tesch spent one year as an assistant at Montana State, followed by a two-year stint as offensive coordinator at Central Missouri State.

A graduate of Moorhead State (Minn.) University who was a free-agent signee with the Atlanta Falcons, Tesch was inducted into the MSU Hall of Fame in the spring of 1998. In 1977, Tesch was the NCAA Division II receiving champion and still holds Dragon single-game and single-season records for receptions.

In 30 years of coaching, Tesch has produced 12 All-America selections and five NFL draft picks.

Jeff and his wife Susan have two children — daughter Tara and son Vincent.
