SMSU vs. USF Series Notes

(all-time results listed on page 8)

Southwest Minnesota State and the University of Sioux Falls meet for the sixth time on Saturday night with SMSU leading 3-2 in a series that started on Sept. 21, 1968, in Marshall ... the first game between the two schools was also the first-ever game in SMSU history ... USF defeated SMSU 13-6 in the first game which was played at Legion Field ... SMSU defeated USF 36-12 in 1969 in Sioux Falls and then won back-to-back games during the 1978 and 1979 seasons ... The two teams have split both games played in Marshall ... USF last played in Marshall on Oct. 21, 1978 ... USF won last season's game 41-22 in Sioux Falls.

The Last Time - SMSU vs. USF

Sioux Falls scored a pair of fourth quarter touchdowns to pull away and earn a 41-22 victory over SMSU on Sept. 29, 2012, in Sioux Falls. **Gannon Moore** scored on a 23-yard run with 10:17 left in the fourth quarter to trim the USF lead to 27-22, but the Cougars answered with back-to-back touchdowns to secure the victory. USF finished the game with 537 yards of offense and 24 first downs, while SMSU racked up 423 yards and 25 first downs. SMSU's **Warren Matthews** rushed for a game-high 99 yards on 14 carries, while **Tyler Peschong** completed 28 of 59 pass attempts for 262 yards and one touchdown. USF quarterback **Taylor Perkins** passed for 317 yards and five touchdowns with **Jeremiah Oates** finishing with five receptions for 112 yards and two touchdowns.

Southwest Minnesota State opens NSIC South play hosting Sioux Falls for annual homecoming game on Saturday

THIS WEEK: The Southwest Minnesota State University (2-2 NSIC, 0-0 NSIC South) football team returns home this Saturday, Oct. 5, to open NSIC South Division play versus the University of Sioux Falls (2-2 NSIC, 0-0 NSIC South). Kickoff for the annual SMSU homecoming game is slated for 6 p.m. at Mattke Field at the Schwan Regional Event Center. Saturday's game features two of the top rushing teams in the country as SMSU enters the game ranked 10th, while USF is ranked 12th. SMSU's **Tyler Tonderum** is second in the country in rushing, while USF's **Nephi Garcia** ranks 30th in rushing (114.3). Southwest Minnesota State is coming off a 41-40 road loss to Bemidji State last Saturday, while Sioux Falls earned a 52-7 home win over Minnesota Crookston. THIS WEEK'S GAME QUICK FACTS:

- A victory for SMSU would move **Cory Sauter** into a tie for third on the SMSU all-time coaching victories list with **Ron Flowers** and **Curt Strasheim**.
- SMSU is playing USF in Marshall for the first time since Oct. 21, 1978.
- Tyler Tonderum** has rushed for more than 100 yards in each of the last three games becoming the first SMSU player to reach the feat since **Josh Schleusner** rushed for more than 100 yards in four straight games in 1999.
- AJ Page** ranks first in the NSIC in both sacks (4.5) and tackles for loss (9.0) and is fourth in tackles (38).
- Tonderum has a pair of 200-yard rushing games in his career (both this season) and is now tied with **Rich Froemling** (1971-74) and **Ken Sather** (1998-2001) for first the most 200-yard rushing games in school history.
- SMSU has scored 30 or more points in 10 of its last 16 games dating back to the final game of the 2011 season.

A VICTORY FOR SMSU WOULD...

- Be its first over USF since Oct. 20, 1979.
- Give SMSU a 3-2 record, which would be its best record after five games since 2009.
- Give **Cory Sauter** a 9-11 record in home games.
- Lift SMSU's all-time record to 172-289-5, including 110-196-5 in conference play.

SMSU ON HOMECOMING: SMSU is 20-24 all-time in homecoming games after snapping a four-game homecoming losing streak last season with a 40-24 win over Wayne State. including losing four straight and 10 of the last 12 games. SMSU is just 3-11 in its last 14 homecoming games since 1999.

SMSU IN THE NCAA STATS: The Southwest Minnesota State offense begins week five ranked 10th in the country in rushing (281.5), 19th in total offense (501.5), 45th in scoring offense (34.8) and 91st in passing offense (220.0). The SMSU defense ranks 72nd in total defense (376.5), 97th in passing efficiency defense (133.5), 109th in scoring defense (32.8) and 102nd in rushing defense (174.5). SMSU IN THE NSIC STATS: SMSU ranks high in several team categories in the NSIC statistics heading into week five. SMSU is first in rushing (281.5), second in total offense (501.5), fifth in scoring (34.8) and eighth in passing (220.0) ... Junior running back **Tyler Tonderum** leads the NSIC in rushing (196.2), scoring (15.0) and all purpose yards (233.2) ... Junior quarterback **Charlie Kern** is sixth in total offense (262.8) and seventh in passing (220.0) ... Sophomores **Jared Twedt** and **Donovan Woods** both are tied for third with two interceptions ... Junior **AJ Page** ranks first in sacks (4.5) and tackles for loss (9.0) and fourth in tackles (38) ... Junior punter **Mike Wenk** is second in punt average (42.2).

TONDERUM BREAKS SCHOOL RECORD: Junior running back **Tyler Tonderum** set the school single-game rushing record in the week two victory at MSU Moorhead on Sept. 14. Tonderum rushed for 343 yards on 42 carries with three touchdowns, breaking the previous record of 243 yards set by **David Whitten** on Oct. 25, 2003. Tonderum is just the 11th player in program history to rush for more than 200 yards in a single-game and the first since **Zach Wysong** in 2008.

MORE TONDERUM IN THE NCAA: Tyler Tonderum's big game at MSU Moorhead not only set an SMSU school record, but it is also the top rushing game among all NCAA schools in the country this season. Tonderum's 343-yard rushing game still ranks as the highest single-game total in all of NCAA football this season for any of the four levels, including FBS, FCS, Division II or Division III. In this week's national statistics he ranks second in rushing with 196.3 yards per game, third in scoring (15.0) and third in all-purpose yards (233.2).

THE HEAD COACH: Southwest Minnesota State head coach **Cory Sauter** is in his fourth season in 2013 and has an overall record of 13-24, including 12-23 in conference games. Sauter was named head coach on March 29, 2010, after serving two seasons as an assistant coach at SMSU. In 2009, Sauter served as the team's offensive coordinator, while in 2008 he served as quarterbacks coach. A complete bio on coach Sauter can be found on page 21.

SAUTER MOVING UP THE LIST: Cory Sauter enters the week with 13 victories and has moved past **Brent Jeffers** into fourth on the SMSU all-time coaching list. He is one victory behind both **Ron Flow-ers** and **Curt Strasheim** for third all-time with 14 victories.

A LOOK BACK AT LAST WEEK: Zach Pulkinen booted a 37-yard field goal with 48 seconds left in regulation to lift Bemidji State to a come-from-behind 41-40 victory over Southwest Minnesota State last Saturday in rainy Bemidji, Minn. BSU rallied from a 37-26 fourth quarter deficit to earn its 13th straight victory over SMSU dating back to the 1997 season. BSU took advantage of an SMSU personal foul and converted a third-and-11 from its own 43-yard line with a 29-yard completion to set-up the game-winning field goal. **Lance Schuveiller** gave SMSU a 40-38 lead with three minutes and 26 seconds left in the game before BSU rallied with the game-winning drive. **Tyler Tonderum** - who entered the game ranked third in the country in rushing - led SMSU with 224 yards and two touchdowns on 34 carries. **Charlie Kern** completed 17 of 42 pass attempts for 241 yards and two touchdowns. **Jordan Cross** caught a game-high five passes for 50 yards and one touchdown, while **Anthony Dean** had four receptions for 99 yards and one touchdown.

MUSTANG DEFENSE MAKING PLAYS: The SMSU defense has forced four turnovers in back-to-back games the past two weeks with four interceptions, four fumble recoveries and one defensive touch-down. The defense made several big plays in its victory over Minot State in week three recording six sacks along with four turnovers. The six sacks were the most by an SMSU defense since recording six on Oct. 6, 2008, at Concordia-St. Paul, while the four turnovers was the highest total since Sept. 11, 2010, at UMary. SMSU also limited Minot State to just 56 yards rushing - the lowest total by an opponent since MSU Moorhead was held to 69 yards on Oct. 8, 2011.

MUSTANG QUICK-HITTERS: Sophomore **McKoy Rodning** had his first career interception at Bemidji State and returned it 15 yards for a touchdown ... Sophomore **Jared Twedt** had a career-high 12 tackles versus Bemidji State ... Junior **Jordan Cross** caught a career-high seven passes for 78 yards and his first career touchdown in the win over Minot State ... Senior linebacker **Dashawn Miller** set a career-high with two sacks versus Minot State ... Sophomore safety **Jared Twedt** had his first two career interceptions versus Minot State ... Junior running back **Caleb Burns** rushed for a career-high 50 yards on 13 carries versus Minot State ... Sophomore cornerback **Andrew McReynolds** tied a career-high with six tackles versus Minot State ... Sophomore linebacker **Blake Pennock** recorded a career-high 12 tackles in the win at MSU Moorhead ... Junior defensive tackle **Antwaun Phillips** - making his first career start - racked up seven tackles with one for loss at MSU Moorhead ... Junior defensive end **AJ Page** set a career-high with three tackles for loss, including two sacks versus St. Cloud State ... Junior defensive tackle **Jacob Levtzow** set a career-high with five tackles versus SCSU ... Sophomore defensive back **Donovan Woods** also recorded a career-high with seven tackles with five solo stops in the loss.

SMSU OFFENSE RACKS UP PLAY AFTER PLAY AFTER PLAY: The Southwest Minnesota State offense has been up-tempo and explosive through four weeks this season averaging 88.5 plays and 501.5 yards per game. SMSU ran 94 offensive plays in the season opener versus St. Cloud State, the highest total single-game total since running 97 versus Bemidji State in a four-overtime game on Oct. 7, 2000. Prior to week one, the last time SMSU ran more than 90 plays in a game was on Nov. 3, 2007, in a triple-overtime game versus Winona State.

LONG DRIVERS: Southwest Minnesota State has put together several impressive drives in the first four weeks of the season. SMSU had three scoring drives of 80 or more yards and had another that covered 75 yards in the week one loss to St. Cloud State, with four of the five scoring drives racking up 10 plays or longer. In week two, SMSU had one 71-yard drive and three other drives that spanned 65 or more yards. In the win over Minot State, SMSU had a pair of 70-plus-yard drives, including a season-long 16-play drive. Last season SMSU recorded just eight scoring drives of 80 or more yards.

CONSECUTIVE GAMES STARTED: A pair of seniors currently have the longest consecutive starts streak on the team. Center **Brandon Puffer** and linebacker **JJ Bobrowicz** have started 26 straight games since the beginning of the 2011 season. On offensive, senior guard **Jake Thiel** and wide receiver **Anthony Dean** have a streak of 16 consecutive games, while on defense junior **AJ Page**, sophomore linebacker **Blake Pennock** and sophomore cornerback **Donovan Woods** have also all started the last 16 games. SPECIAL TEAMS LEADERS: Redshirt freshman **Max Mattila** leads the team with six tackles on special teams this season with all six coming on kickoff returns. Freshman **Dallin Finley** has five tackles, including three on kickoff coverage and two on punt return.

WENK RETURNS TO THE FIELD: Junior punter **Mike Wenk**, who missed all of last season with an injury suffered in fall camp, returned to action this season and has played in three games with a 42.2 yard average with five punts inside the opponents' 20-yard line. Wenk a two-time All-NSIC honoree, missed the MSU Moorhead game in week two with an injury.

TONDERUM NAMED NSIC PLAYER OF THE WEEK: **Tyler Tonderum** was named the NSIC Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 16 following his record-breaking performance at MSU Moorhead. He is the first SMSU player to earn the weekly award since Gannon Moore on Oct. 20, 2010.

TEAM RUSHING RECORD ALSO SET: Southwest Minnesota State set a team record in the victory at MSU Moorhead with 416 yards rushing, breaking the previous record of 397 yards set on Oct. 8, 2011. SMSU racked up 67 rushing attempts, just missing the program single-game record of 69 attempts set on Oct. 13, 1973.

IMPRESSIVE DEBUT: Junior quarterback **Charlie Kern** made his first career start in the week one loss to St. Cloud State and put up very solid numbers. Kern completed 36 of 55 passes for 307 yards and two touchdowns, while also rushing for 54 yards and one touchdown. Kern's 300-yard passing game is the first by an SMSU quarterback since **Tyler Peschong** in week one in 2012. Kern's 36 completions were the most by an SMSU player since Peschong completed 31 in a loss to Concordia-St. Paul on Nov. 12, 2011.

NEWCOMERS MAKE AN IMPACT: Southwest Minnesota State had a total of 16 players make their first appearance in Mustang uniforms in week one, including five true freshmen. The true freshman include defensive back **Dallin Finley**, defensive tackle **Rakeem Felder**, defensive tackle **Alex Werner**, receiver **Jay Schneider** and running back **Ashanti Payne**. Werner suffered an injury in week two and will miss the remainder of the season, but is expected to receive a medical redshirt.

2013 TEAM CAPTAINS: Four players, two on offense and two on defense, have been named team captains for the 2013 season. The team captains were selected by a vote of the Mustang players. The offensive team captains selected were senior offensive center **Brandon Puffer** and junior quarterback **Charlie Kern**. The defensive team captains named were senior safety **Tate Bunkers** and junior defensive tackle **Jacob Levtzow**.

GET IN THE "ZONE": Southwest Minnesota State has scored on 15 of its 17 possessions this season inside the "red zone" with 12 touchdowns and three field goals. SMSU opponents are 14 of 15 (93.3) inside "red zone" with 13 touchdowns and one field goal. The following is SMSU in the red zone since 2004.

HOLDING ONTO THE BALL: Winning the turnover margin is a major key to winning at any level of football. SMSU is plus-5 this season after four weeks, including forcing four turnovers in both the week three win over Minot State and the loss in week four to Bemidji State. SMSU finished plus-7 in turnover margin last season, which was one of the best in school history. SMSU had a streak of not committing a turnover in four straight games and did not commit a turnover in five of 11 overall.

Since the start of the 2004 season (103 games), SMSU has been a "plus" in turnover margin in just 28 games (three in 2004, two in 2005, one in 2006, two in 2007, three in 2008, three in 2009, two in 2010, three in 2011, seven in 2012 and two in 2013). In SMSU's last 81 conference games, which spans from late in the 2004 season through week four this season, SMSU is minus-36 in turnover margin. The Mustangs have been "even" or "minus" in turnover margin in 57 of their last 81 conference games.

THE 2013 SMSU ROSTER: The 2013 roster features 102 players (as of Sept. 30) with 15 seniors, 18 juniors, 14 sophomore, 23 redshirt freshmen and 32 freshmen. The roster includes players from 12 different states with Minnesota leading the way with 38, followed by Wisconsin (17), Iowa (12), South Dakota (9), Illinois (8), Florida (6), California (4), Colorado (2), Texas (2), Alaska (1), Georgia (1), Nebraska (1) and Arizona (1).

MUSTANGS AT HOME: The 2013 season marks the sixth year for SMSU football at Mattke Field at the Schwan Regional Event Center. SMSU is 14-17 all-time at the REC, including 1-1 this season. The \$16 million facility opened in the fall of 2008 with the first college football game played on Aug. 30.

RECORD ON THE ROAD: Southwest Minnesota State is 1-1 in road games this season after finishing the 2012 season with a 1-4 record in five road games. The last time SMSU won at least two road games in a season came in 2009 and the last time the team won three road games in a season occurred in 2008. SMSU is a combined 20-44 in road games since 2000.

NSIC PRESEASON POLL: Southwest Minnesota State was picked to finish 12th overall in the 16-team Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll and was picked to finish seventh in the eight-team NSIC South Division.

ALL-NSIC RETURNERS: SMSU returns four players this fall who earned All-NSIC South Division honors in 2012. Senior center **Brandon Puffer** was named second team All-NSIC South, while senior offensive lineman **Kyle Johnson**, senior offensive lineman **Jake Thiel** and senior safety **Tate Bunkers** were all named to the honorable mention All-NSIC South squad. Junior punter **Mike Wenk** was named second team All-NSIC South in 2011, but missed last season with an injury.

PRESEASON HONORS: Four Mustang players received preseason accolades from various websites and publications. USA College Football named senior center **Brandon Puffer** to its preseason All-America second team, while senior left guard **Jake Thiel** was named third team. Senior safety **Tate Bunkers** and senior tackle **Kyle Johnson** were both named to the honorable mention team.

2012 SMSU RUSHING SOME OF THE BEST: SMSU finished the 2012 season with 1,888 rushing yards on 385 carries, which ranked as the second highest total in school single-season history. SMSU did set the school single-season record with a 4.9 yards per rush average. The 1973 team holds the overall rushing record with 1,945 yards on 515 carries.

MORE ON 2012 RUSHING: SMSU rushed for 23 touchdowns in 2012 setting the school single-season record. SMSU also averaging 171.6 yards per game, which ranks second in school history. The 1973 team holds the record averaging 194.5 yards per game.

MUSTANG HISTORY: The 2013 campaign marks the 46th season of college football at Southwest Minnesota State dating back to 1968. SMSU owns an all-time record of 171-289-5, including 109-196-5 in conference play. SMSU has recorded eight winning seasons and has made two NAIA playoff appearances (1987 and 1991). The program earned its lone conference championship in 1990.

FOR OPENERS REWIND: Southwest Minnesota State is now 20-26 all-time in season openers following the week one loss to St. Cloud State. SMSU has lost its last three season-opening games and is now 24-22 all-time in home openers.

WORKING OVERTIME: SMSU has played in nine overtime games since the NCAA added the extra session in 1998. SMSU is 3-6 all-time in overtime games including 1-3 in multi-overtime games following last year's 34-31 double overtime loss to Minnesota State on Oct. 13. SMSU's last overtime victory was at Upper Iowa (40-34) on Oct. 23, 2010.

2013 REGION REMAINS THE SAME: Southwest Minnesota State is a member of Super Region 3 for the second straight season are matched with the Mid-American Intercollegiate Athletic Association (MIAA), the Great Northwest Athletic Conference (GNAC) and the Great American Conference (GAC) for the NCAA playoffs.

THE CORY SAUTER SHOW: *The Cory Sauter Show* airs weekly on Marshall's local cable access channel Studio 1. The show is broadcast Monday through Friday nights at 10 p.m. and can also be viewed at SMSUmustangs.com.

MUSTANGS ON RADIO: All SMSU football games during the 2013 will be broadcast on Marshall Radio, 105.1 FM KARL. Ryan Rohlik is in his first season as the play-by-play voice of SMSU football.

ABOUT SIOUX FALLS: The Cougars are coming off a 52-7 drubbing of Minnesota Crookston last Saturday in Sioux Falls, S.D. USF amassed 680 yards of offense in the game, including 467 on the ground. Junior running back **Nephi Garcia** racked up a game-high 167 yards and one touchdown on 18 carries, while freshman quarterback **Luke Papilion** rushed for 77 yards and a pair of touchdowns. Senior wide out **Carrington Hanna** caught seven passes for 84 yards and one touchdown. Garcia leads the team with 457 rushing yards on 72 carries this season, while Papilion has 387 yards and nine touchdowns on 62 carries. Papilion has completed 43 of 104 passes for 452 yards and one touchdown with five interceptions. Hanna has amassed a team-high 17 receptions for 166 yards and one touchdown. Sophomore line-backer **Carter Ahlers** and junior defensive back **Broughan Jantz** each have a team-high 30 tackles with Ahlers recording 3.0 tackles for loss. **Jed Stugart** is in his fourth season as head coach at Sioux Falls with a record of 29-9. He came to USF after spending three seasons (2006-08) as head coach at MidAmerica Nazarene University (Kan.) compiling a 26-7 record and leading MNU to a pair of NAIA playoff appearances. In his first season at USF in 2010, Stugart led the Cougars to the NAIA national championship game before losing 10-7 to Carroll College and finishing the season 13-1.

SMSU Head Coach Cory Sauter

Cory Sauter enters his fourth season as head coach at Southwest Minnesota State in 2013 and his sixth overall on the Mustang coaching staff. He has led SMSU to a record of 11-22 in three seasons on the sidelines, including 10-21 in Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference play.

Named the 10th head coach in program history on March 29, 2010, after serving a month as interim head coach, Sauter brings six years of professional football playing experience in both the National Football League and NFL Europe, along with both collegiate and professional football coaching experience to the Mustang program.

During Sauter's first season as head coach in 2010, the Mustangs started the season 2-0 and were 4-4 after eight weeks, before suffering several injuries to key positions and finishing 4-7 overall. Seven Mustang players earned all-conference honors, including quarterback Ryan Ratekin, who became the first SMSU offensive player to earn first team All-NSIC honors since 2006.

In 2011, SMSU finished with a 3-8 overall record and had eight players earn All-NSIC honors. Junior quarterback Tyler Peschong

led the NSIC in passing and total yards and was named second team All-NSIC South Division. The Mustang offense ranked third in the conference in passing and eighth in scoring.

In his third season at the helm in 2012, Sauter helped oversee an offense that set a school record with 23 rushing touchdowns, while rushing for 1,888 yards, the second highest total in program history. The Mustang

offense – which scored 30 or more points six times - ranked 62nd in the country in scoring and 65th in total offense. Senior running back Warren Matthews was named first team All-NSIC, while senior running back Gannon Moore was named second team All-NSIC.

Prior to becoming head coach, Sauter spent two seasons (2008-09) helping lead a high-powered Mustang offensive attack as quarterbacks coach and offensive coordinator.

Serving as offensive coordinator, quarterbacks coach and passing game coordinator in 2009, SMSU averaged 36 points per game, the third highest in school history, and also scored 30 or more points in eight games tying a school single-season record.

SMSU junior quarterback Ryan Ratekin was named the 2009 NSIC Offensive Newcomer of the Year, setting a school record with a 63.9 percent completion percentage, while passing for 2,963 yards and 33 touchdowns, the third highest in school history.

SMSU senior quarterback Josh Shudlick had a record breaking season during Sauter's first season on the sideline in 2008, setting a conference record for passing yards and tying the league record for touchdown passes in one

season. The Mustang offense lead the NSIC in passing yards, while Shudlick finished first in the conference in passing yards per game and total offense.

Prior to SMSU, Sauter, a native of Hutchinson, Minn., spent several years coaching at both the collegiate and professional levels. In 2006 he served as quarterbacks/receivers coach for the Hamburg Sea Devils in NFL Europe and was also a graduate assistant at the University of Minnesota. In 2007 he was quarterbacks coach for the Berlin Thunder.

A 1997 graduate of the University of Minnesota, Sauter had a record-setting career as quarterback for the Golden Gophers and spent six seasons in the NFL from 1998-2004. He played four seasons for Minnesota (1994-97), including starting the final 34 games of his collegiate career and playing in the Blue-Gray All-Star Football Classic following his senior season. He finished his career as the school's all-time career record holder for pass completions, pass attempts and passing yards. Sauter earned his master's degree from the University of Minnesota in 2003.

Following his collegiate career Sauter spent six seasons in the NFL from 1998-2003. He signed as a free agent with the Arizona Cardinals in 1998 before spending time with the Detroit Lions, Chicago Bears and Indianapolis Colts. He appeared in one regular season game in his career completing 6 of 9 passes for 59 yards in a 2002 game with the Chicago Bears. He also played one season for the Barcelona Dragons in NFL Europe.

Cory and his wife Amy, live in Marshall with their two daughters, Berlin and Estella.
